Church family,

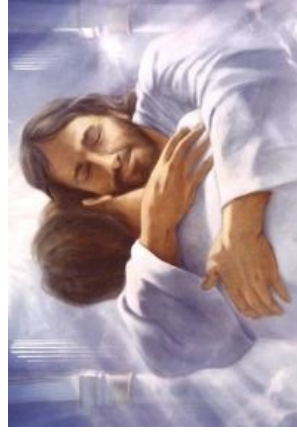
